## ALL STUDENTS

- One zippered pencil case with:
  - Standard black or blue ink pens (erasable preferred)
  - Red ink pens
  - Four different colored highlighters
- One art/project case with:
  - Colored pencils
  - Washable colored markers
  - Glue
  - Scissors
  - Tape
- Loose leaf paper
- Lunch pack – **mandatory** (Eagle Store has bags available for purchase)
- NIV Bible ( Eagle Store has Bibles available)
- Combination lock - **mandatory**

### Math

- Pencil holder that holds shavings
