

## SUMMER READING 2010



Students entering Grades 2 through 8 are required to participate in our summer reading program to maintain and improve their reading skills. Students entering Grades 2 through 8 are required to read all books listed for their particular grade. Upon returning to school in September, students in Grades 4-8 will review their summer reading books with their literature teachers and will be tested. Test grades will be recorded for the First Marking Period. Students in Grades 2-3 are required to bring a note signed by a parent indicating the books were read and credit will be given to the student towards
